Opinion

- Evaluate the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Management and Board of Directors.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the Board of Directors' use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Company's ability to continue as going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial results or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions that may cause the Company to cease to continue as going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the standalone financial results, including the disclosures, and whether the financial results represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in the internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with the relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

1. The company has been declared and classified as Non-Performing Asset by State Bank of India on 28/12/2021 and The Wai Urban Co-Operative Bank Ltd on 30/11/2021.
2. It has been observed that, company has following statutory dues outstanding as on 31.03.2025. Following are the detail for the same:

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Emphasis of matter

1. There are advances paid to supplier amounting to Rs. 8.96 crores outstanding at the end of the financial year.
2. There is inventory amounted to Rs. 2.44 crores which are slow moving or obsolete inventory. Adequate provisions for diminution in value have not been passed.

Other matters

The statement annual financial results include the results for the half year ended 31st March, 2025 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited half yearly figures, which were subject to limited review by us.
